History: Wine has been made at Chateau de Montfaucon since the XVIth Century. The old cellars are still used for barrel ageing. In 1420 the King of France conferred the title of Baron to Montfaucon. One of his sons was known as Le Petit Baron. This wine has been named after him.

Location: Just across the Rhône river from the esteemed vineyards of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, this estate is owned by Baron Rodolphe de Pins. One of the strengths of Montfaucon is the diversity of soils and exposure combined with a large selection of Rhone grape varieties, which contribute to the great quality and complexity of its wines.

Blend: This is a Rhone blend using Carignan, Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedré grapes.

Pairing Suggestions: Exceptionally versatile. I have successfully paired it with just about everything from biryani, Paella, Shammi Kebab and even sabji. Try it.

Tasting Notes: Montfaucon's red and white wines were both Medal winners at the Decanter World Wine Awards 2013. Rodolphe de Pins seeks elegance and harmony in his wines and looks towards burgundy for inspiration. This wine shows cheerful and bright fruit notes. Just open a bottle and enjoy as you wish. It is suitable for any occasion.
