One of Rodolphe's ancestors had a daughter who was referred to as La Demoiselle de Montfaucon. This wine has been after her.

Location: Just across the Rhône river from the esteemed vineyards of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, this estate is owned by Baron Rodolphe de Pins.

Blend: 60% Cinsault, 20% Caunoise, 10% Carignan and 10% Grenache

Pairing Suggestions: Exceptionally versatile. I have successfully paired it with butter garlic prawns, biryani, Paella, Shammi Kebab and even sabji. Try it.
